CCA TALENT SHOW



We are excited to announce CCA's Got Talent will be held on June 6th!

If your child is considering submitting an audition video, please read through the following expectations carefully:

- Audition Submissions: All performers must submit a video audition (1 minute max) showcasing their talent. Please ensure your video is clear and shows the talent in its best light.
- 2. **Show Details:** Students are **performing LIVE on June 6th** (we will not be showing video submissions) with each performance lasting up to 2 minutes maximum. If your child's song or music is longer than 2 minutes, we ask that you work with your child to find a good spot to end. *We ask all participants to please honor this timeline so we can have as many participants as possible.

- 3. **Music Submission:** If your child's performance requires pre-recorded music, a downloadable MP3 file of the music must also be submitted. All music must be school-appropriate (clean lyrics).
- 4. **Important Dates:** Auditions are due on May 12th and selection will be announced on May 20th. Please note that not all performers will be selected for the show.
- 5. **Agreement:** By submitting an audition, the performer's family agrees to send all necessary files (the audition video and any MP3 music files) to the talent show coordinators. All music files will be requested following selection and will be shared to kargreen@rvschools.ab.ca (please do not use the @rockyviewschools.ab.ca email address).

UNIVERSAL SUPPORTS IN OUR CLASSROOM

At CCA, we use a variety of universal supports to help all students stay engaged and ready to learn. In the classroom, all students have access to various tools, including, but not limited to, wobble chairs, wobble cushions, TheraBand, timers, and small fidget tools. These supports help students focus, move safely while learning, and manage their energy levels in a way that promotes success.

We also have a special area called the "Pit Stop," which includes an exercise bike and a rebounder (small trampoline). These tools give students the opportunity to take short movement breaks, helping them reset and return to learning with fresh focus.

By incorporating these supports into our routines, we work to create a learning environment where every child can thrive!

About the OurSCHOOL Student Survey:

- Allows students to share their feedback anonymously on their experiences at school, school environment, and school improvement programs.
- Based on their feedback, students have the opportunity to be involved in action plans fostering increased student engagement
- Participation in the survey is **voluntary**, however, all students are encouraged to participate.
- The time required to complete the survey may vary, but it is designed to be completed in approximately 35-40 minutes during their school day.

Thank you to everyone who has created a WheresTheBus account and started using the app to track your child's bus! RVS has now fully transitioned to using WhereTheBus, and is no longer using the Bus Status App to share bus information.
